Portrait:

Airport Hannover–Langenhagen GmbH (founded 1952)
(Shareholders are federal state of Lower Saxony/State capital Hanover each 35%, fraport 30%)

Int. commercial airport with terminals A, B, C. Passenger capacity of up to 10 million. Parallel railway system. The airport covers an area totalling more than 310,000 m² with 20 aircraft stands directly on the handling building, 26 outer stands as well as a General Aviation Terminal (GAT). There is an air freight centre capable of handling a total capacity of up to 60,000 tons annually. Direct connection to all major transport routes. In 2006 more than 5.7 million passengers passed through Hanover airport. The flight schedule services over 100 direct destinations in more than 30 countries with more than 700 aircraft movements a week. A fantastic infrastructure with permission for 24 hour operation, an attractive shopping centre, two business hotels, an S-Bahn station suitable for ICE trains with connections to the exhibition centre, as well as over 14,000 parking spaces guaranteeing the highest productivity. A logistics centre linked up to the apron rounds off Hanover airport's highly efficient infrastructure.
