Portrait Grotian–Steinweg

Portrait:

The Grotian–Steinweg pianoforte factory has been in the family ownership for six generations. In 1830, Friedrich Grotian went to Moscow and opened a music shop and started to build pianos. In 1854 he returned to his home country and met Theodor Steinweg and became a partner in his piano factory that had been founded in 1835. In 1865 Theodor Steinweg sold his shares of the company to the Grotian family which is named Grotian–Steinweg since 1919. Soon after that the company belonged to the premium class piano maker in Germany. This is proofed by uncountable statements in guest books and letters from pianists like for example: Clara Schumann, Paul Hindemith, Walter Gieseking, Ivo Pogorelich and Lars Voigt. Since more than 50 years the company also pays close attention to the promotion of young pianists. Therefore we do have our own piano competitions.
